
How to Keep Thursday Golf Emails from Going to Spam

Generally speaking, if my email addresses (see below) are in your provider address book (or contacts) then my emails will not go to spam. That's called whitelisting.

Notice I said provider's address book. You may have a local address book that works with your local email application that has my email addresses in it, but that will only work locally. It will not prevent your provider (Gmail, Yahoo!, AOL, Comcast, etc.) from sending emails to its designated spam (or junk) folder. So you must add the contact at the provider level.
