Scripture: Romans 15:14-33

OPEN:

1. What "hot spot" in the world would you gladly accept a round-trip ticket for two? To what "hot spot" would you refuse to go, even if all expenses were paid?

DIG:

- 1. From your reading of Romans, what are some of the major points Paul has stressed?
- 2. How does Paul define his ministry (v 15-16)? What motivates and inspires him (vv 17-19)? Illyricum (v 19) was present day Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, and Slovenia; about 1300 miles from Jerusalem? What does that tell you about Paul?
- 3. Why was a collection taken in Macedonia and Achaia (vv 25-27)? What principles about giving can be learned from this example?
- 4. What were two prayer requests does Paul make (vv 30-32)? Why does he mention these requests to the Christians in Rome?
- 5. How would you describe Paul's ministry based on this passage (vv 14-33)?

REFLECT:

- 1. What is your chief ambition in life? What are some of your minor ones. Why do you think you have these ambitions?
- 2. How do you know when you're fulfilling your destiny?
- 3. When you hear the word "missionary", what are your first thoughts?
